OUR SERVICES

York West EarlyON Child and Family Centre provides opportunities for children 0-6 years of age to participate in play, inquiry-based programs. At the York West EarlyON Child and Family Centre, parents and caregivers can:

- Engage in early learning and literacy programs for parents/care providers and their children.
- Engage in programs to support parents and caregivers in all aspects of early child development.
 - Get information and training for new parents about pregnancy and parenting.
 - Get information and referrals to other community programs and services.

• Get parenting information workshops and referrals to consultants from health, speech development and many more.

REGISTRATION

What to Expect?

On your first visit, a staff member will welcome you to the Centre. We will then invite you to complete our "new client" registration form.

An overview of our programs and services offered at Yorkwest EarlyON and Jane Finch Centre will be shared, in addition to our program calendar.

Each visit to Yorkwest EarlyON Centre, will require sign-in of both guardian(s) and child. This is to ensure the safety of all participants present in our spaces. For the safety of our valued familes and staff we require registration to ensure safety and capacity limits. Walk-Ins are welcome in the event we are not at capacity.



CAREGIVERS

We encourage you to spend time in the program and get involved in the activities provided. You are responsible at all times for the child/ren in your care. Please do not leave children alone. The centre does not have child minding services (childcare), unless it is part of a special program (18months+). By law, the Centre must report any suspected child abuse to the Children's Aid Society. Please ask staff if you have any questions about this. Spending time with your child is extremely important; therefore, the use of cellphones while in a program with your child is prohibited. Help us in keeping our space clean. Please put any toys that have been in your child's mouth in the cleaning bin. Tidying-up is something families can do together. We can show you how! Since children belong to the vulnerable population, taking pictures of children in the program is forbidden, unless signed documentation is present. The Centre is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged belongings. To keep our environment clean, during wet environmental changes, footwear must be completely dry and free of any

and all debris before entering the program space. Walking

bare feet at any point will not be permitted.

In cases of fire drill/alarm please:

1. Calmly escort your child to the designated area (staff will assist you) 2. DO NOT gather belongings 3. Stay with your own child at all times 4. Follow staff directions 5. Do not proceed to centre until advised If you want to leave while you are outside, kindly inform a staff member

If you are unsure please give us a call before attending the program.
